

# Heirloom Stitches

## Basic Baby Hat

Just a basic hat for a very special baby!

**Supplies:** 1 skein dk weight yarn (approx. 125 yds)  
Size 6-16" circular needle or size to obtain gauge  
Size 6 DPN or size to obtain gauge  
1 Marker  
Pom Pom Maker

**Gauge:** 22 sts over 4"

**To Begin:** CO 72 sts, pm, join in the round being careful not to twist.  
Work in stst until piece measures 5"

**Crown:** \*K7, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
Work 1 round even between each decrease round.  
\*K6, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
\*K5, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
\*K4, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
\*K3, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
\*K2, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
\*K1, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round  
\*K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round

**Finishing:** Cut an 8" tail. Thread a yarn needle and run needle through each stitch while slipping the stitch off the needle. Pull yarn tight and fasten. Make small pom pom and attach to top of hat. The brim will roll on its own.
