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Size 2(4,6)

Materials:

**SIERRA**

80% pima cotton 20% merino wool 191yards 100 grams  
3(4,5) skeins salmon color 05 "A"

**BABY ALPACA CHUNKY**

100% Baby Alpaca 108 yards 100 grams  
1 skein winter white color 565 "B"

**CLOUD 9**

50% merino wool 50% angora 109 yards 50 grams  
2 (2,3) skeins winter white color 101 "C"  
size 5 and 7 needles  
2 blue 4 hole buttons - 1/2"  
1 yard tube elastic - white - 1/16"  
embroidery needle  
black thread  
size G/6 crochet hook

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 26 rows = 4"

Stripe pattern: \*2 rows B, 2 rows A; repeat from\* (4 rows)

Knitted measurements:

chest - 26 (28, 31)"

body length 15 1/4 ( 16 1/4, 17 1/4)" unrolled sleeve length 13 (13 1/2, 14) unrolled armhole depth 5 3/4 (6 1/4, 6 3/4)"

**Back:**

With larger needles and A cast on 64 (70, 78) sts. Wk in St st until piece measures 15 1/4( 16 1/4, 17 1/4)" from beg. On WS bind off.

**Front:**

Work as back until piece measures 5 1/4 (6 1/4, 7 1/4)" from beg. On RS and A, wk 23 (26, 30) sts, join B and wk 18 sts chart pattern #4, end 23 (26, 30) sts. When complete, continue in A until piece measures 12 3/4 ( 13 3/4, 14 3/4)" from beg.

*neck shaping:* On RS K 27 (29, 33)sts, join second ball of yarn and bind off center 10 (12, 12)sts, wk to end. Wk both sides at once, bind off 3 sts from each neck edge once, then decrease 1st every other row twice. Wk even until piece measures 15 1/4 ( 16 1/4, 17 1/4)" from beg. Bind off remaining 19 ( 21, 25) sts for each shoulder.

## **Sleeves:**

Stripe pattern: \*4 rows B, 4 rows A; repeat from \* ( 8 rows)

With larger needles and A cast on 32 (32, 34) sts. Wk in St st for 1 1/2".

Cont in St st and stripe pattern, increase 1 st at each side on row #1 and each side every 6th row until 58 (62, 66) sts are reached.

Wk even until piece measures 13 ( 13 1/2, 14)" from beg. Bind off.

## **Finishing:**

Block pieces to measurements. Sew left shoulder seam.

neckband: With RS facing, with smaller needles and A, pick up 72 (74, 74) sts evenly around neck. Wk in

k1 p1 rib for 6 rows. On RS wk in St st for 1". Bind off on WS. Sew 2nd shoulder and neckband seam.

Mark 5 3/4 (6 1/4, 6 1/2)" down from each shoulder at armhole edge. Sew top of armhole edge between

markers. Sew remaining side and sleeve seams.

**Eyes:** With black thread attach buttons as indicated on chart in "x" formation.

**Ears(2):** With larger needles and C, cast on 3 sts. Increase 1 st at each end every other row until 7 sts are

reached. Wk even for 3", then decrease every other row until 3 sts remain. Cut yarn and pull through remaining



sts. With C embroider chain st around ear, attach as indicated on chart at top and bottom.

nose: with crochet hook and strand of A, chain 12 sts. Spiral into circle and attach as indicated on chart.

**Whiskers(2):** Cut 2 pieces of elastic 4 1/2" long, attach as indicated on chart - fold each piece in half, pull

through and knot fringe. With white thread secure each whisker at knot.
