CHALET & CHATEAU

Baby Alpaca • Bamboo

Chateau is MountainTop **Chalet's** colorful cousin: the same super-soft blend in eight vibrant, heathery colors. Both yarns are decadently soft with a lovely drape in a chunky weight and both look great knit at a wide variety of gauges and textures.

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approx 20 $\frac{3}{4}$ " circumference on the sawtooth edge (measured above short rows) and 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " circumference at the Garter Stitch edge

YARN

Chateau by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(70% baby alpaca, 30% bamboo;
50 g = approx 98 yards)
2 hanks 1431 Periwinkle (shown with
sawtooth edge at the top)

MountainTop Chalet by **Classic Elite**

(70% baby alpaca, 30% bamboo;
50 g = approx 98 yards)
2 hanks 7438 Chestnut (shown with
sawtooth edge at the bottom)

NEEDLES

Knitting needles in size US 8 (5 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

GAUGE

18 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Garter
Stitch. **Take time to save time, check
your gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately
BO: bind off
CO: cast on
dec('d): decrease(d)
inc('d): increase(d)
k: knit
k2tog: knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
patt: pattern
pm: place marker
rep: repeat
st(s): stitch(es)
yo: yarn over (1 st inc'd)

PATTERN STITCH

Garter Stitch (Gtr st): Knit all sts, every row.

COWL

CO 33 sts.

Set-up row: K7, pm, k26.

Work in patt as follows: Slip marker as you come to it.

*Row 1: Knit to marker, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, k3 – 34 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Knit to marker, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, k4 – 35 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Note: DO NOT wrap and turn on short rows. The turn is hidden in the “valley” of the Gtr st and by the firmness of the gauge.

Short row set 1: K20, turn, knit to end; k10, turn, knit to end.

Row 5: Knit to marker, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, k5 – 36 sts.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Knit to marker, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, k6 – 37 sts.

Row 8: Knit.

Row 9: Knit to marker, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, k7 – 38 sts.

Row 10: Knit.

Short row set 2: K10, turn, knit to end; k20, turn, knit to end.

Row 11: Knit to marker, (yo, k2tog) twice, yo, k8 – 39 sts.

Row 12: BO 6 sts, knit to end – 33 sts.

Rep from * 12 more times (13 times total).

BO all sts knitwise.

FINISHING

Sew BO edge to CO edge. Weave in ends. Block lightly, if desired.
