



GAUGES

18 sts and 25 rows = 4"/10 cm in Stockinette stitch using larger needles
 17 sts and 32 rows = 4"/10 cm in Garter stitch using larger needles

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGES

PATTERN STITCHES

Garter Stitch (Garter st) worked in rounds

Knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.

Stockinette Stitch (St st) worked in rounds

Knit every round.

NOTE: TEE is worked in the round from the top down. Change to longer circular or double-pointed needles as stitches allow.

YOKE

With smaller circular needle, cast on 85 (96, 106, 116, 127) sts. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Pm for beg of rnd.

SIZES

X-Small (**Small**, Medium, **Large**, XL)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Bust 31½ (35½, 39½, 43½, 47½)"/80 (90, 100.5, 110.5, 120.5) cm

Length 17½ (18, 18½, 19½, 20½)"/44.5 (45.5, 47, 49.5, 52) cm

MATERIALS

• 5 (5, 6, 7, 8) balls Tahki Yarns **COAST**, 55% wool, 45% cotton (1.75 oz/50g; 126 yds/ 117m) in color **#14 cranberry**

- Size 6 (4mm) circular needles, 16"/40cm and 32"/80cm long

- Size 7 (4.5mm) circular needles, 24"/60 cm and 32"/80cm long

OR SIZES TO OBTAIN GAUGES

- One set size 6 (4mm) double-pointed needles (dpn)

- One set size 7 (4.5mm) double-pointed needles (dpn)

- Stitch markers & holders

- Yarn needle

[Knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd] 4 times.

Change to larger circular needle.

Knit 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd P1 (0, 2, 0, 3), *M1p, p4; rep from * around – 106 (120, 132, 145, 158) sts.

Work even in Garter st until piece measures 2 (2, 2, 2½, 2½)", end with knit rnd.

Inc Rnd P1 (0, 0, 1, 2), *M1p, p3; rep from * around – 141 (160, 176, 193, 210) sts.

Work even in Garter st until piece measures 4½ (4½, 5, 5, 5½)", end with a knit rnd.

Inc Rnd M1p (0, 0, **M1p**, 0), *p2, M1p, p3, M1p; rep from * around to last 1 (0, 0, 0, 0) st, p1 (0, 0, 0, 0) – 198 (224, 246, 270, 294) sts.

Work even in Garter st until piece measures 5½ (5½, 6, 6, 6½)", end with a purl rnd.

Change to St st and work even until piece measures 7½ (8, 8½, 9, 9½)".

Shape Armholes

Dividing Rnd: K30 (34, 38, 42, 45) for Left Back, slip next 39 (44, 48, 52, 57) sts to stitch holder for Left Sleeve, cast on 11 (12, 14, 15, 17) sts, k60 (68, 75, 83, 90) for Front, slip next 39 (44, 48, 52, 57) sts to stitch holder for Right Sleeve, cast on 11 (12, 14, 15, 17), k30 (34, 37, 41, 45) for Right Back.

Body

Row 1 K35 (40, 45, 50, 54), pm for Left Side, k71 (80, 89, 98, 107), pm for Right Side, k36 (40, 44, 48, 53) – 142 (160, 178, 196, 214) sts.

Continue St st, inc 1 st on either side of each Side marker every 19 (19, 19, 20, 21) rnds 3 times – 154 (172, 190, 208, 226) sts. Work even until piece measures 9½ (9½, 9½, 10, 10½)" from Armhole.

Change to smaller circular needle.

[Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd] 3 times.

Bind off purlwise.

Sleeves

With larger dpns, join yarn at center of Armhole cast-on edge, pick up and knit 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) sts along cast-on edge, then 1 st at side of Armhole opening, knit across 39 (44, 48, 52, 57) from Sleeve stitch holder, pick up and knit 1 st at side of Armhole opening, then 6 (6, 7, 7, 8) sts along rem cast-on edge – 52 (58, 64, 69, 76) sts.

Pm for beg of rnd.

Dec Rnd 1 K5 (6, 7, 8, 9), k2tog, k37 (42, 46, 50, 55), ssk, k6 (6, 7, 7, 8) – 50 (56, 62, 67, 74) sts.

Knit 6 rnds.

Dec Rnd 2 K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 48 (54, 60, 65, 72) sts.

Work even in St st until Sleeve measures 2½ (3½, 3½, 4, 4)" from Armhole.

Change to smaller dpns.

[Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd] 3 times.

Bind off purlwise.

FINISHING

Block piece to measurements.

Weave in ends.

SPECIAL TERMS

K2tog: Knit 2 together (dec) – Knit 2 sts tog through the front loops.

P2tog: Purl 2 together (dec) – Purl 2 sts tog through the front loops.

[For multiple decs, work as above using the number of sts specified.]

M1: Make 1 (inc) – Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, [knit or purl as indicated by pattern st].

M1p: Make 1 purlwise (inc) – Insert left-hand needle under loop 2 rows below last stitch worked, insert right-hand needle purlwise in loop and purl.

Ssk [or ssp]: Slip, slip, knit [or purl] (dec) – Slip 2 sts, one at a time KNITWISE to right-hand needle, return the sts to left-hand needle in the turned position and knit [or purl] them together through the back loops.
