Whether your drink is hot or cold, protect your fingers with these cute cup cozies! They're sized to fit around standard to-go cups, so you'll always know which one is yours.

Yarn

RED HEART® Detroit: 1 ball each 05682 Pink Freesia **A**, 05673 Lilac **B**, 08305 Candy **C**

RED HEART® Detroit, Art. 9809651 available in 100 g (3.5 oz), 266 m (291 yd) balls

OR

RED HEART® Lisa: 1 ball each 05682 Pink Freesia **A**, 05673 Lilac **B**, 08305 Candy **C**

RED HEART® Lisa, Art. 9809619 available in 50 g (1.76 oz), 133 m (145 yd) balls

Additional Requirements

Double-Pointed Needles: One set 3.75 mm [US 5]

Yarn needle

Stitch markers

TENSION/GAUGE: 20 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 28 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Stockinette stitch. **CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge.**

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Size

Fits standard to-go coffee cup.

Box Stitch Cozy Circumference: 19 cm [7½"]

Moss Panels Cozy Circumference: 18 cm [7"]

Eyelet Mock Cable Cozy Circumference: 18 cm [7"]

Height: 10 cm [4"]

Special Abbreviation

kfb (Knit into front and back) = knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle.

NOTE

Cozies are worked in the round from the bottom up.



BOX STITCH COZY

With **A**, cast on 40 sts. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Rounds 1-5: *K2, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 6 and 7: *P2, k2; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 8 and 9: *K2, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 10-25: Repeat Rounds 6-9.

Rounds 26 and 27: Repeat Rounds 6 and 7.

Rounds 28-32: Repeat Round 1.

Bind off all sts in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.



MOSS PANELS COZY

With **B**, cast on 40 sts. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Rounds 1-5: *K3, p5; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 6: *P3, k1; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 7-9: *K1, p1, [k1, p2] twice; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 10 and 11: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 12 and 13: *K1, p1, k2, [p1, k1] twice; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 14 and 15: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 16-24: Repeat Rounds 7-15.

Rounds 25-27: Repeat Rounds 7-9.

Round 28: Repeat Round 6.

Rounds 29-33: Repeat Round 1.

Bind off all sts in pattern.



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FINISHING

Weave in ends.



EYELET MOCK CABLE COZY

With **C**, cast on 40 sts. Join, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Rounds 1-5: *K2, p3; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 6: *Slip 1 knitwise, k2, pass slipped st over k2, p2; repeat from * to end of round—32 sts.

Round 7: *K1, yo, k1, p2; repeat from * to end of round—40 sts.

Rounds 8 and 9: *K3, p2; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 10-25: Repeat Rounds 6-9.

Round 26: Repeat Round 6—32 sts.

Round 27: *K1, kfb, p2; repeat from * to end of round—40 sts.

Rounds 28-31: Repeat Round 1.

Bind off all sts in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Colour A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarnover; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** or ****** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
