Additional Requirements
1 pair each 4.00mm (UK 8) (US 6) Knitting Needles
and 3.25mm (UK 10) (US 3) Knitting Needles.
4 Stitch Holders.
A Wool Needle for sewing seams.

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TENSION

With Correct Yarn and Tension, your garment will look like our photograph.

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm Needles.

To work a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, use 4.00mm Needles, cast on 33 sts. Work 46 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely. Please check your tension carefully. If less sts use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

BACK

Using 3.25mm Needles and CC, cast on 70 (74-82-86-94-98) sts.

1st row - K2, * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd row - P2, * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows 4 (4-4-5-5-5) times ... 10 (10-10-12-12-12) rows rib in all. Break off CC.

Change to 4.00mm Needles and beg patt.

Using MC for rem, 1st row (RS) - Knit.

2nd row - Purl.

3rd row - K2, * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

4th row - P2, * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

5th row - Knit.

6th row - Purl.

7th row - As 4th row.

8th row - As 3rd row.

Rows 1 to 8 incl form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 25 (28-30-33-34-35) cm from beg, ending with a 4th or 8th patt row.

SHAPE RAGLAN ARMHOLES -

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 66 (70-78-82-90-94) sts.

Next row - K1, sl 1 knitways, K1, psso, patt to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Work 3 rows patt.

Rep last 4 rows until 60 (64-72-72-84-86) sts rem, ending with a dec row. **

Cont dec one st (as before) at each end of every foll alt row until 26 (28-30-34-36-38) sts rem.

Work 1 row. Leave rem sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Cont dec one st (as before) at each end of every foll alt row until 48 (50-54-58-60-64) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

SHAPE NECK -

Next row - K1, sl 1 knitways, K1, psso, patt15 (15-17-18-19-20), turn.

*** Cont on these 17 (17-19-20-21-22) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at raglan edge in every foll alt row

10 (10-11-11-11-12) times, AT SAME TIME dec one st at

neck edge in every foll alt row 5 (5-6-7-8-8) times ... 2 sts.

Next row - P2, turn. K2tog. Fasten off. ***

Slip next 12 (14-14-16-16-18) sts onto a stitch holder and leave.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem sts and patt to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Rep from *** to ***.

SLEEVES

Using 3.25mm Needles and CC, cast on 34 (38-38-42-42-42) sts.

Work 10 (10-10-12-12-12) rows rib as for lower band of Back.

Break off CC.

Change to 4.00mm Needles and beg patt.

Using MC for rem, work 4 rows patt as for Back.

Cont in patt (8 rows form patt rep) and working extra sts into patt, inc one st at each end of every foll - 4th (6th-6th-8th-10th-10th) row until there are 44 (42-44-46-60-62) sts, then in every foll - 6th (8th-8th-10th-12th-12th) row until there are 54 (56-60-62-62-64) sts.

Cont in patt without shaping until work measures approx 23 (28-33-38-40-42) cm from beg, ending with a 4th or 8th patt row.

SHAPE RAGLAN -

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 50 (52-56-58-58-60) sts.

Next row - K1, sl 1 knitways, K1, psso, patt to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Work 3 rows patt.

Sizes 6, 8, 10 and 12 years only - Rep last 4 rows (1-2-3-4) time/s.

All Sizes ... 48 (50-52-52-50-50) sts.

Dec one st (as before) at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 8 sts rem.

Work 1 row.
Leave rem sts on a stitch holder.

NECKBAND

We recommend using Mattress Stitch seam unless otherwise stated.

Join raglan seams, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline and leaving left back raglan open.


With right side facing, using 3.25mm Needles and CC, knit across sts from left sleeve stitch holder, knit up 22 (22-23-24-25-25) sts evenly along left side of neck, knit across sts from front stitch holder, knit up 22 (22-23-24-25-25) sts evenly along right side of neck, knit across sts from right sleeve stitch holder, then knit across sts from back stitch holder ... 98 (102-106-114-118-122) sts.

Work 7 rows rib as for lower band of Back, beg with a 2nd row. Cast off loosely in rib.


MAKE UP

Join left back raglan and neckband seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in all ends.

MAKE 1 (M1)



Pick up loop which lies before next stitch, place on left hand needle and knit (or purl) into back of loop.
