

DESIGN NO 4 ROMPER SUIT

BABY MILK

SIZES	0-3 mts	3-6mts	6-12mts	12-18mts
FINISHED MEASUREMENTS				
Length of inside leg

Waist width (stetched)				
	25	27	29	31 ins

MATERIALS

1 pair each of size 4mm (US6) and 4½ mm (US7) needles. 2 buttons

Baby milk

Shade 4 170 185 200 215 grms

Elastic for waist at back.

TENSION

Measured over st.st. using 4½mm needles and yarn doubled 19sts x 28rs = 10 cms (4 ins) square. Knit a tension square if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit. P = purl. st(s) = stitch(es). rs = rows. wk = work. inc = increase(ing).
dec = decrease(ing). alt = alternate.beg = beginning. patt = pattern. ins = inches. RSF/WSF = right / wrong side facing. rem = remaining. cont = continue. tog = together. rep = repeat. NR. = next row. foll = following. yf = yarn forward. tbl = through back of loop. St.St. = stocking stitch (RSF knit. WSF purl).

K2 loop = pick up the horizontal loop between last stitch worked and next stitch and leave on right hand needle, knit next 2sts then pass the picked up loop over these 2sts and off the needle.

BACK

LEFT LEG

With 4mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 32(32,36,36)sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs twice more inc 8(10,8,10)sts evenly along the last row. 40(42,44,46)sts.

Change to 4½mm needles and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) Knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2 rs until wk measures 9(10,11,12)cms [3½(4,4½,5) ins] from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Break off yarn and put sts on a st holder.

RIGHT LEG

Wk exactly as given for left leg but do not break off yarn.

JOIN LEGS AND SHAPE CROTCH

NR: K40(42,44,46)sts from right leg, turn and cast on 5sts, turn and K40(42,44,46)sts from left leg. 85(89,93,97)sts.

NR: Purl to end.

NR: K38(40,42,44)sts, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K38(40,42,44)sts.

NR: Purl to end.

NR: K38(40,42,44)sts, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K38(40,42,44)sts.

NR: Purl to end.

NR: K38(40,42,44)sts, K2tog, K1, K2tog, K38(40,42,44)sts. 79(83,87,91)sts rem.

NR: Purl to end.

NR: Knit to end.

NR: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2rs for 10(11,12,14)cms, [4(4½,5,5½) ins] dec 13sts evenly along the last wrong side row. 66(70,74,78)sts rem. **

Wk rib as follows:

Row 1: K2, * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Row 3: As row 1.

Row 4: P2tog, * K2tog, P2tog, rep from * to end. 33(35,37,39)sts rem.

Row 5: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 6: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs twice more. Cast off.

Fold the K1, P1 rib in half to inside and slip stitch in place

Insert elastic through rib and secure at each side.

FRONT

Wk as given for back up to **

Wk rib as follows:

Row 1: K2, * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs for a further 6 rs.

Wk Bib as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) P1, K1, [P2, K2] twice, P2, K42(46,50,54), P2, [K2, P2] twice, K1, P1. 66(70,74,78)sts.

Row 2: K1, P1, [K2, P2] twice, K2, P42(46,50,54), K2, [P2, K2] twice, P1, K1.

Row 3: Rib as set 12sts, K2tog tbl, K10(12,14,16), [K2 loop, K2] 4 times, K2 loop, K10(12,14,16), K2tog, rib as set 12sts. 64(68,72,76)sts rem

Row 4: Rib as set 12sts, P40(44,48,52), rib a set 12sts.

Row 5: Rib as set 12sts, K2tog tbl, K36(40,44,48)sts, K2tog, rib as set 12sts. 62(66,70,74)sts rem.

Row 6: Rib as set 12sts, P38(42,46,50)sts, rib as set 12sts.

Row 7: Rib as set 12sts, K2tog tbl, K8(10,12,14), [K2 loop, K2] 4 times, K2 loop, K8(10,12,14), K2tog, rib as set 12sts. 60(64,68,72)sts rem.

Row 8: Rib as set 12sts, P36(40,44,48)sts, rib as set 12sts.

Cont as set working K2 loop as set on rs 11, 15 and 19 AT THE SAME TIME dec 1 st at each side as set on the next and every foll alt row until 22 rs worked.

46(50,54,58)sts rem.

NR: rib as set 12sts, K2tog tbl, K1, P2, K2, P2tog, P1, K2, [P2, K2] 0(1,2,3) times, P1, P2tog, K2, P2, K1, K2tog, rib as set 12sts. 42(46,50,54)sts rem.

NR: Rib as set to end.

NR: Rib as set to end.

NR: (WSF) * K2tog, P2tog, rep from * to last 2sts, P2tog. 21(23,25,27)sts rem.

NR: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

NR: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last row once more. Cast off

STRAPS (make 2)

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 10sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) K2, P2, K2, P2, K2.

Row 2: K1, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K1.

Rep the last 2 rs until strap measures 21cms, [8½ ins]

Make buttonhole

NR: Patt 4sts, yf, wk2sts tog, patt 4sts.

Patt a further 4rs. Cast off.

MAKEUP

Sew up outer and inside leg seams. Sew on straps. Sew on buttons.

DESIGN NO 5
SIDE BUTTONED JACKET

BABY MILK

SIZES	3-6mts	6-12mts	12-18mts	18-24mts
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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width	20 51	22 56	24 61	26 ins 66 cms
Length	10 25	11 28	12 30	13 ins 33 cms
Sleeve Length	5 12	6 15	7 18	8 ins 20 cms

MATERIALS

1 pair of 4½ mm (US 7) knitting needles. 3.25mm (US 3) crochet hook. 3 buttons

Baby milk

Shade 3	100	125	150	175 grms
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TENSION

Measured over PATT using 4½mm needles and yarn doubled 23sts x 32rs = 10 cms (4 ins) square. Knit a tension square if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit. P = purl. st(s) = stitch(es). rs = rows. wk = work. inc = increase(ing).
dec = decrease(ing). beg = beginning. patt = pattern. ins = inches. RSF/WSF = right / wrong
side facing. rem = remaining. cont = continue. rep = repeat. foll = following. ch = chain, tr =
treble.

BACK

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 58(64,70,76)sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: Knit to end.

The last 2 rs set the pattern.

Rep the last 2 rs until back measures 19(20,21,23)cms [7½(8,8½,9) ins] from beg ending with a wrong side row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES RSF

Cast off 6sts at the beg of the next 2 rs. 46(52,58,64)sts rem.

Patt straight until armhole measures 6(8,9,10)cms, [2½(3,3½,4) ins] ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 38(42,46,50)sts and wk patt as given for back until front measures same as back up to beg of armhole shaping ending with a right side row.

SHAPE ARMHOLE WSF

Cast off 6sts and patt to end. 32(36,40,44)sts rem.

Patt straight until front is 18(20,22,24)rs shorter than back.

SHAPE NECK RSF

Cast off 20(22,24,26)sts and patt to end. 12(14,16,18)sts rem.

Patt straight until front measures same as back. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 18(20,22,24)sts and wk in patt as given for back until front measures same as back up to beg of armhole shaping ending with a wrong side row.

SHAPE ARMHOLE RSF

Cast off 6sts and patt to end. 12(14,16,18)sts rem.

Patt straight until front measures same as back ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

SLEEVES

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 32(34,36,38)sts and wk in patt as given for back for 6 rs.

Then cont in patt AT THE SAME TIME inc 1 st at each end of the next row and 2 foll 8th rows. 38(40,42,44)sts.

Patt straight until sleeve measures 12(15,18,20)cms, [5(6,7,8) ins]. Cast off.

MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams. Sew sleeve cast off row to armhole on body sewing the cast off 6sts on body to the side of the sleeve.

Sew up side and sleeve seams matching patt.

BODY CROCHET EDGING

With 3.25mm crochet hook and using yarn single wk as follows:

Slip stitch yarn to right side seam, * 3ch, 3tr into same stitch, skip 3sts, slip stitch into next st, rep from * across right front, up right front edge (skipping 3rs), across right front neck, up right front neck, across back neck, down left front to hem, across left front hem and across back.

Slip stitch to first stitch. Fasten off.

Sew on 3 buttons, the first one just below neck shaping, the 3rd one 7cms up from hem and the remaining button spaced evenly between.

SLEEVE EDGING

With 3.25mm crochet hook and using yarn single wk as follows:

Slip stitch yarn at seam * 3ch, 3tr into same stitch, skip 3sts, slip stitch into next st, rep from * across cuff, slip stitch to first stitch. Fasten off.

DESIGN NO 6

BOTTLE COVER

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 5 ins
12cms

Length 8½ ins
21 cms

MATERIALS

4½mm (US7) knitting needles. 4.00mm (US6) crochet hook
Baby Milk
Shade 4 60grms

¾ metre of NARROW ribbon. Small motif

TENSION

Measured over pattern using 4½mm needles and yarn doubled 28sts x 31rs = 10 cms (4 ins) square. Wk a tension square if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit. P = purl. st(s) = stitch(es). rs = rows. wk = work. dec = decreasing. RSF = right side facing. rep = repeat. beg = beginning. yf = yarn forward. tog = together.
cont = continue. patt = pattern. ch = chain.

COVER

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 35sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) K3, [P1, K3] 8 times.

Row 2: K1, [P1, K3] 8 times, P1, K1.

Rep the last 2rs until wk measures 1½ ins from beg ending with a row 2.

*MAKE EYELETS

NR: (RSF) patt 3sts, [yf, wk2sts tog, patt 2sts] 7 times, patt 4sts. *

Beg with row 2 cont in patt until wk measures 15½ ins from beg ending with a row 2.

Rep * to * once more.

Beg with row 2 cont in patt for a further 1½ ins ending with a row 2.

Cast off.

Fold piece in half and stitch side seams. Insert ribbon through eyelets beg and ending at centre front.

Sew motif to front of cover.

Join yarn at side seam and with 4.00mm crochet hook and using yarn doubled, * wk 3ch, skip 2sts, slip stitch into next st, rep from * across cast off and cast on row. Fasten off.

DESIGN NO 7

PINK BOW

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 6 ins
15 cms

Length 10 ins
25 cms

MATERIALS

4½mm (US 7) knitting needles.
Baby Milk
Shade 3 75grms
½ metre of 2 inch width ribbon. Stuffing
Small toy for decoration.

TENSION

Measured over pattern using 4½mm needles and yarn doubled 18sts x 27rs = 10 cms (4 ins) square. Wk a tension square if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit. P = purl. st(s) = stitch(es). rs = rows. wk = work. WSF = wrong side facing. rep = repeat. beg = beginning.

K1B = insert needle through centre of stitch below next stitch on needle and knit this in the usual way slipping the st above off needle at the same time.

BOW

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 30sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (WSF) Knit to end.

Row 2: K1, * K1B, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 3: Knit to end.

Row 4: K1, * K1, K1B rep from * to last st, K1.

Rep these 4 rs until wk measures 20 ins from beg ending with a row 3. Cast off.

Fold wk in half lengthways and stitch cast on row to cast off row.

This seam is the centre of the bow.

Stitch side seams leaving a few inches of one seam open.

Stuff bow and stitch remainder of seam.

Wrap yarn around centre to gather in tightly to complete bow. Stitch ribbon to centre of bow on one side and then stitch toy to centre of bow on the other side.

DESIGN NO 8

BLUE BOW

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 6 ins
15 cms

Length 10 ins
25 cms

MATERIALS

4½mm (US7) knitting needles.

Baby Milk

Shade 4 75grms

½ metre of 2 inch width ribbon. Stuffing

Small toy for decoration.

TENSION

Measured over pattern using 4½mm needles and yarn doubled 23sts x 32rs = 10 cms (4 ins) square. Wk a tension square if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit. P = purl. st(s) = stitch(es). rs = rows. wk = work. RSF = right side facing. rep = repeat.

BOW

With 4½mm needles and using yarn doubled cast on 33sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) K1, * P1, k1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: Knit to end.

Rep these 2 rs until wk measures 20 ins from beg ending with a row 2. Cast off.

Fold wk in half lengthways and stitch cast on row to cast off row.

This seam is the centre of the bow.

Stitch side seams leaving a few inches of one seam open.

Stuff bow and stitch remainder of seam.

Wrap yarn around centre to gather in tightly to complete bow. Stitch ribbon to centre of bow on one side and then stitch toy to centre of bow on the other side.
