Circular needle and double pointed needles size 2 ½ and 3 mm – US 1or 2 and 2 or 3 – UK/Canadian 13 or 12 and 11

Gauge: 28 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 3 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SWEATER

Using needles size 3 mm and dark grey yarn, cast on 240-264-288-312-336-360 sts Work 6 rnds in Garter st. Work patt I as charted. Place markers at each side 121-133-145-157-169-181 sts for front, and 119-131-143-155-167-179 sts for back. When patt I is ready, cont working in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 41-42-42-42-42-43 cm/16.1-16.5-16.5-16.5-16.9 in. Bind off 16 sts at each side (8 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit the sleeves.


SLEEVES

Using needles size 3 mm and dark grey yarn, cast on 60-60-60-72-72.72 sts. Work 6 rnds in Garter st. Knit 1rnd, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 73-75-79-83-85-89 sts. Cont working in rnds in patt III (check from mid st where to beg patt). Place a marker beg of rnd = mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 3-2 ½ - 3-3-3-2 ½ cm/1.2-1-1.2-1.2-1.2-1 in until there is altog.103-107-109-113-117-123 sts on a rnd. When III is ready, cont working in St st with dark grey yarn until sleeve measures the given length or as desired. Bind off 16 sts mid under sleeve (8 sts both sides of the marker). Slip rem sts on holder. Leave work aside, and knit same for the other sleeve.

Raglan: Slip all sts on same circular needle, with sleeves over the bound-off sts = 382-414-442-474-506-542 sts on a rnd. Work 2 rnds in St st with dark grey yarn, and dec evenly across first rnd number of sts to be 380-408-440-468-492-528 sts. Place markers at each 4 seam line. Cont working in rnds in patt II as charted (check from mid st where to beg patt for each piece) and beg same time raglan-dec every 2nd rnd as foll: Work until 3 sts rem before a marker – K2togtbl – K2 – K2. Rep dec at each 4 seamline until 100-120-128-148-156-176 sts rem on a rnd (cont working in St st with grey yarn after patt in is ready, and work measures approx. 64-65-66-66-67-68 cm/ in). Dec evenly across number of sts to be 100-120-128-134-140-144 sts. Change to needles size 2 ½ mm, and cont working in K1,P1 rib with dark

grey yarn until neck band measures approx. 14-14-14-15-15-15 cm/5.5-5.5-5.5-5.9-5.9-5.9 in. Bind off in rib. Sew under arm seams, and weave in all ends on WS.





White, 600 :

15-16-17-18 balls

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 3 – US 2 or 3 – UK/Canadian 11

+ zipper

Gauge: 28 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 3 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Raglan-dec for patt A on front:

1st row : Dec as explained.

2nd row : Work without dec.

3rd row : S1 1 st, K2tog, pssso (rep only this dec on front).

4th row : Work without dec.

Rep these 3 rows.

Using needles size 3 mm, cast on 268 – 292 – 312 – 336 sts.

Work as foll: Garter st over 5 sts (= right front) P2,K2 rib over next 258 – 282 – 302 – 326 sts, end with Garter st over 5 sts (= left front). Work back and forth as established until rib measures approx. 4 cm/1.6 in. Place markers each side, 67 – 73 – 78 – 84 sts for each front, and 134 – 146 – 156 – 168 sts for back. Inc for cable patt as foll: Garter st over 5 sts, inc 20 sts over next 54 sts (= 74 sts) = patt A. St st over 48 – 60 – 70 – 82 sts, inc 20 sts over next 54 sts (= 74 sts) = patt A, St st over 48 – 60 – 70 – 82 sts, inc 20 sts over next 54 sts (= 74 sts) = patt A, and end with Garter st over 5 sts = 328-352-372-396 sts on a row. Cont working as established until work measures approx. 48-49-48-49 cm/18.9-19.3-18.9-19.3 in. Bind off 18 sts at each side for armholes (9 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit sleeves.

Sleeves : Using needles size 3 mm, cast on 52 – 56 – 56 – 60 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Place a marker beg of the rnd (= mid under sleeve).

S-size: Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 54 sts.

All sizes: St st over 0 – 1 – 1 – 3 sts, inc 20 sts over next 54 sts (= 74 sts) = patt A, end with St st over 0 – 1 – 1 – 3 sts. Cont working as established, and inc 1 st both sides of the marker (= St st over inc sts) approx. every 1 cm/ in until there is 144 – 148 – 154 – 160 sts on a rnd, and sleeve measures approx. 48 – 49 – 50 – 51 cm/ 18.9-19.3-19.7-20.1in. Bind off 18 sts mid under sleeve (9 sts both sides of the marker). Leave work aside, and knit same for the other sleeve.

Raglan-dec (Note! Read through before starting):

Cont working in patt same as before, taking all pieces on same circular needle size 3 mm (also front edges). Slip sleeves over the bound-off sts for armholes = 544 – 576 – 608 – 644 sts on a row.


Place marker mid back (all measures are taken from here). Place markers at each seam line, and beg raglan-dec: Work until 5 sts rem before 1st marker, sl 1 st, K1, pssso, P2, K2, P2, K2tog. Rep dec at each 4 seam line every **2nd row** over **St st-panels**, but for patt A, see boxed instruction above.

When work measures approx. 23 – 24 – 25 – 26 cm/9.1-9.4-9.8-10.2 in (measured from mid back marker), work 1 row in St st over all sts (not fronts, and 6 sts for raglan-dec = 2 purl-sts, 2 knit-sts, 2 purl-sts), and dec evenly across number of sts to be (dec 20 sts over each cable patt) = 132 – 136 – 144 – 148 sts on a row. Change to needles size 2 ½ mm, and work back and forth in K2,P2 rib (not front edges). When neck band measures approx. 6 cm/2.4 in, bind off 5 sts at each edge (= front edges). Cont working back and forth until neck band measures approx. 12

cm/4.7 in. Bind off in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Finishing : Sew under arm seams. Sew on zipper.

Dark Pink, 660 : 9 – 10 – 11 – 12 balls

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 2½ and 3 mm – US 1 or 2 and 2 or 3 – UK/Canadian 13 or 12 and 11

Gauge: 28 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 3 mm. 36 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over patt A using needles size 3 mm.

Check your gauge to ensure success.

PATTERN A

1st rnd : P1, *sl 1 st tbl holding yarn on back, K2, sl 1 st over 2 knit-sts and 2 purl-sts*, rep *-* across the rnd, and end with P1.

2nd rnd : P1, *K1, 1 yo, K1, P2*, rep *-* across the rnd, and end with P1.

3rd rnd : P1, *K3, P2*, rep *-* across the rnd, and end with P1.

4th rnd : Same as 3rd rnd.

Rep these 4 rnds.

Raglan-dec for patt A, front:

1st rnd : Dec as explained.

2nd rnd : Dec as explained.

3rd rnd : Work without dec.

Rep these 3 rnds.

Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 246 – 270 – 294 – 318 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 – 4 – 5 – 5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in in K1,P1 rib. Place markers each side, 123 – 135 – 147 – 159 sts for both front and back. Change to needles size 3 mm. Inc for cable patt as foll: Inc 37 – 40 – 43 – 47 sts evenly across over 123 – 135 – 147 – 159 sts for front = 160 – 175 – 190 – 205 sts for patt A, and work St st over 123 – 135 – 147 – 159 sts for back. Cont working as established until work measures approx. 44 – 44 – 44 – 44 cm/17.3-17.3-17.3-17.3 in. Bind off 20 sts at each side for armholes (9 sts on back and 11 sts on front). Leave work aside, and knit the sleeves.

Sleeves : Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 60 – 64 – 66 – 70 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3 mm. Place a marker beg of rnd (= mid under sleeve). Work in rnds in St st. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 1 ½ cm/0.6 in until there is altog. 118 – 124 – 128 – 134 sts on a rnd, and sleeve measures approx. 48 – 49 – 50 – 51 cm/18.9-19.3-19.7-20.1 in. Bind off 18 sts mid under sleeve (9 sts both sides of the marker). Leave work aside, and knit same for the other sleeve.


Yoke: Knit all pieces on same circular needle size 3mm. Slip sleeves over bound-off sts for armholes = 443 – 482 – 517 – 556 sts on a rnd. Place marker at each 4 seamlines, and beg raglan-dec: Work until 7 sts rem before a marker, sl 1 st, K1,psso,work patt I, K2tog. Rep dec at each 4 seamline. Note! Rep raglan-dec on St st-panels (back and sleeves) every 2nd rnd, **but** on front see the boxed instruction.


Rep dec altog. 35 – 39 – 42 – 46 times for back, and 46 – 51 – 55 – 59 times for front. Knit 1 rnd over all sts, and dec evenly across front the rnd number of sts to be 53 – 57 – 63 – 67 sts.

Neck band: Change to needles size 2½ mm, and work approx. 7 – 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-2.8-3.1-3.1 in in K1,P1 rib. Turn work inside out. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work in rnds 7 – 7 – 8 – 8 – cm/2.8-2.8-3.1-3.1 in St st. Change to needles size 2½ mm, and work 6 rnds in Garter st.

Finishing : Sew under arm seams.

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 2 ½ and 3 mm – US 1 or 2 and 2 or 3 – UK/Canadian 13 or 12 and 11 + 8 buttons

Gauge: 28 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 3 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

CARDIGAN

Using needles size 3 mm and black yarn, cast on 241-265-289-313-337-361 sts. Work back and forth 6 rows in Garter st. Work patt I as charted. Place markers at each side, 125-137-149-161-173-185 sts for back, and 58-64-70-76-82-88 sts for each front. Cont working in rnds, and cast on 5 sts mid front (= purl each rnd, will be cut open, not included in total number of sts). When work measures approx. 36-37-38-38-39-39 cm/ 14.2-14.6-15-15-15.4-15.4 in, work patt II as charted (work 5 purl-sts mid front with basic clr). When patt is ready, cont working in St st with black yarn, and bind off for neck edge as foll: Bind off mid 31-31-33-33-35-35 sts (incl. 5 purl-sts mid front). Cont working back and front, and bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x4 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1 st (same for all sizes). When work measures 64-65-66-66-67-67 cm/25.2-25.6-26-26-26.4-26.4 in, bind off or slip sts on holder.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 3 mm, cast on 60-60-60-72-72-72 sts. Work back and forth 6 rows in Garter st. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 75-79-81-85-89-93 sts. Cont working in rnds in St st and patt III. Place a marker beg of rnd = mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every, 2-2-2-2-2-2 cm/ 0.8-0.8-0.8-0.8-0.8-0.8 in until there is altog. 113-117-123-129-133-139 sts on a rnd. When patt III is ready, cont working in St st with black yarn until sleeve measures the given length, or as desired. Turn inside out, and work 5 rnds in St st for seam allowance, Bind off.
Work same for the other sleeve.

Finishing

Sew dense zigzag seams mid front and around armholes. Cut open between seams.


Sew shoulder seams.

Neck band: Using needles size 2½ mm, pick or knit up approx. 130-134-138-140-140 sts. Work 2 ½ cm/1 in in Garter st, Bind off.

Left front band: Beg from RS. Using needles size 2½ mm and black yarn, knit or pick up approx. 178-182-184-184-188-188 sts. Work 14 rows in Garter st.


Right front band: Work same as for left front band, but make 8 buttonholes after 6 rows. Make first buttonhole approx. 3 cm/1.2 in inside lower edge, last mid neck band, and rest evenly spaced apart (approx. 7 – 7 ½ cm/2.8-3 in). Buttonhole: Bind off 3 sts. Next row: Cast on 3 sts over the bound-off ones.



ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Alpaca Fine (85% Alpaka Superfine – 15% highland wool), Viking Nordlys (75% superwash wool, 25% nylon), 100 g ball, Viking Baby ull (100% merino wool, superwash). Viking pure milk fiber (100% milk fiber), 50 g ball

Light Grey, 613: 12 - 13 - 14 - 15 balls

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 3 mm – US 2 or 3 – UK/Canadian 11

Gauge: 28 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 3 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 3 mm, cast on 105-119-133-147 sts. Work in patt I until work measures approx. 26-26-28-28 cm/10.2-10.2-11-11 in (end patt as charted). Work 1 row in St st (= RS), and inc evenly across number of sts to be 126-140-154-168 sts. Cont working in patt II until work measures 76-78-78-80 cm/29.9-30.7-30.7-31.5 in (or desired length). Bind off.

FRONT


Work same as for back until work measures 68-70-70-72 cm/26.8-27.6-27.6-28.3 in (or approx. 8 cm/3.1 in less than total length). Bind off mid 30-32-34-34 sts. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x4 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2sts and 1x1 st. When front measures same as back, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

Finishing

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams, leaving approx. 25 m/9.8 in for armholes.

Armhole ands: Pick or knit up approx. 140 sts around armhole. Work 6 rnds in Garter st. Bind off.

Neck band/Hood: Using needles size 3 mm, pick or knit up approx. 130-134-138-138 sts around neck edge. Work 3 rnds in St st. Next rnd: Inc 1 st to each st = 260-268-276-276 sts. Cont working in rnds in patt II as charted until work measures approx. 45 cm/17.7 in (Note! End with a complete Garter st-stripe). Bind off.

Green, 630 : 5 – 5 – 6 – 6 balls

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 2½ and 3 mm – US 1 or 2 and 2 or 3 – UK/Canadian 13 or 12 and 11 + 1 big button

Gauge: 28 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 3 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Using needles size 2½ mm, cast on 257 – 281 – 305 – 329 sts. Work back and forth 4 rows in Garter st. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work as foll: Garter st over 8 sts (= right front edge), patt A over 241 – 265 – 289 – 313 sts, and end with Garter st over 8 sts (= left front edge). Place markers each side, 66 – 72 – 78 – 84 sts for each front, and 125 – 137 – 149 – 161 sts for back. Work patt A twice in height, and cont after that in St st. When work measures approx. 19 – 20 – 21 – 22 cm/7.5-7.8-8.3-8.7 in, bind off at each side 10 sts for armholes (5 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and fronts separately.

Back: Cont working in St st. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x3 sts, 2x2 sts, and 1x1 st. When work measures approx. 38 – 40 – 42 – 44 cm/15-15.7-16.5-17.3 in, slip 21 mid sts on holder. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x8 – 8 – 9 – 10 sts and 1x5 – 6 – 6 – 6 sts. Cont working until work measures approx. 40 – 42 – 44 – 46 cm/15.7-16.5-17.3-18.1 in.

Left front: Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 31 – 32 – 34 – 36 cm/12.2-13-13.4-14.2 in, slip 9 – 10 – 10 – 11 first sts on holder. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x5 – 5 – 6 – 6 sts, 2x3 sts, 2x2 sts and 3x1 st. Cont working until front measures same as back.


Right front: Work same as left front, rev all shaping. Make buttonhole inside 2 sts from front edge same time when you slip neck edge sts on holder. Buttonhole: Bind off 4 sts (cast on 4 sts over the bound-off sts when knitting the neck band).

Sleeves: Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 89 – 93 – 97 – 101 sts. Work 4 rnds in Garter st. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work patt A (1 time), and inc evenly across 1st rnd number of sts to be 93 – 97 – 101 – 105 sts. Place a marker beg of rnd = mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 1 cm/0.4 in. When patt A is ready, cont working in St st until there is 115 – 121 – 127 – 133 sts on a rnd, and sleeve measures approx. 12 – 13 – 14 – 15 cm/4.7-5.1-5.5-5.9 in. Bind off 10 sts mid under sleeve (5 sts both sides of the marker). Cont working back and forth in St st. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 2x3 sts, and the 2 sts beg of each row until 11 sts rem. Bind off 1x3 sts at each edge. Bind off rem sts.

Finishing : Sew shoulder seams. Sew on sleeves.

Neck band: Beg from right front. Using needles size 2½ mm, knit or pick up (remember to cast on 4 sts over buttonhole) approx. 128 – 134 – 138 – 142 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Bind off (not too loosely).



Cont working in **rnds**: P3, *inc 2 sts over next 4 sts = patt I, P6*, rep *-* across the rnd, end with P3 = 492 – 540 – 588 – 636 sts on a rnd, and 12 sts for each report. Cont working as established, **and** dec 1 st both sides of each cable approx. every 4 ½ – 5 – 5 ½ – 6 cm/1.8-2-2.2-2.4 in 3 times until work measures approx. 15 – 16 – 17 – 18 cm/5.9-6.3-6.7-7.1 in. When all purl-sts are decreased and there is 246 – 270 – 294 – 318 sts on a rnd, cont working in St st until work measures approx. 40-43-45-47 cm/15.7-16.9-17.7-18.5 in. Bind off 18 sts at each side for armholes (9 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit the sleeves.

Sleeves: Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 84 – 84 – 90 – 96 sts. Work back and forth 6 rows in Garter st. Change to needles size 3 mm. Cont working in rnds. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 112 – 112 – 120 – 128 sts. Place a marker beg of rnd = mid under sleeve. Work in patt II (end as charted), and after that cont in St st. When work measures approx. 8 – 9 – 9 – 10 cm/3.1-3.5-3.5-4 in, bind off 18 sts mid under sleeve (9 sts both sides of the marker). Leave work aside, and knit the other sleeve.

Yoke: Knit all pieces on same circular needle size 3 mm, with sleeves over the armholes = 398 – 422 – 462 – 502 sts on a rnd. Place markers at each 4 seam lines, and beg raglan-dec: Work until 2 sts rem before a marker, sl 1 st, K1,pssso, K2tog. Rep dec at each 4 seamline every 2nd rnd until 126 – 134 – 142 – 150 sts rem on a rnd. Change to needles size 2 ½ mm. Cont working approx. 12 cm/4.7 in K1,P1 rib. Bind off rather loosely in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Finishing : Sew under arm seams.

BOLERO

Gauge with double yarn, Chicago + Alpaca Fine: 18 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 6 mm.

Using needs size 2½ mm and Alpaca Fine (single strand) , cast on 54 – 60 – 60 – 66 sts. Work back and forth 6 rows in Garter st. Change to needles size 3 mm, and cont working in rnds. Work in patt A until work measures approx. 10 cm/4 in (end after 1st rnd). Work 1 rnd in St st, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 208-224-240 sts. Cont working in rnds in St st. Place 6 markers as foll: Note! Place markers between 2 sts. Place markers at each side, 104-112-120 sts for both back and front, 2 markers for both front and back, 34-37-40 sts **from** both side markers. Cont working in St st, and dec 1 st both sides of the markers as foll: Dec first both sides of the side makers, and then next time both sides of the 4 markers front and back. Rep dec every 12th rnd altog. 8 times = 160-176-192 sts rem on a rnd. When work measures approx. 43-47-52 cm/16.9 – 18.5 – 20.5 in, bind off 12 sts at each side (6 sts both sides of side markers). **Yoke:** Cast on 58-62-70 sts over the armholes (= sleeves) = 252-276-308 sts on a rnd. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 325 – 375 – 420 sts. Work in patt A, rep 4 times in height (end after 1st rnd). Cont working in St st, and dec evenly across 1st rnd number of sts to be 252-276-300 sts. Cont working in rnds in St st, and dec on 2nd rnd as foll: *K10, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Rep dec every 8th rnd with 1 st less between dec 2 times, and then every 6th rnd altog 4 times = 105-115-125 sts on a rnd. Cont working until work measures approx. 15-16-17cm/5.9 – 6.3 – 6.7 in, measured from cast-on edge of the sleeves. Work in patt A, 3 times in height (= neck band). Knit 1 rnd over all sts, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 78 – 84 – 92 sts. Work 4 rnds in Garter st. Bind off very loosely.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Armhole bands: Using needles size 3 mm, pick or knit up approx. 66-70-76 sts around armholes. Work approx. 3 cm/1.2 in in Garter st. Bind off. Work same for the other armhole band.

Use some extra yarn (will be unraveled) and needles size 3 mm, and cast on 60 sts. Work 4 rows in St st. Change to white yarn, and work as foll: *K18, patt A over 12 sts, and K30. Turn.

P30, patt A, and P18. Turn.

K18, patt A, and K24. Turn.

P24, patt A, and P12. Turn.

K12, patt A, and K18. Turn.

P18, patt A, and P6. Turn.

K6, patt A, and K12. Turn.

P12, patt A. Turn.

Patt A, K6. Turn.

P6, patt A, P18. Turn.

K18, patt A. Turn.

Patt A, P18*

Rep *-* altg. 22 times. Join cast-on edge and open sts on needle.

Close the hole on top.

Lower edge band: Using needles size 3 mm, cast on 14 sts. Work as foll: Patt A over 12 sts, Seed st over 2 sts. Cont working as established until work measures approx. 48 cm/18.9 in (or the required circumference). Join band into a ring (= cast-on edge and open sts on needle).

Sew band to the lower edge of beret, to first st of patt A.

SCARF

Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 80 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 120 sts.

Work in patt A until work measures approx. 16 cm/6.3 in (end cable patt as charted). Work 1 rnd in St st, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 80 sts. Cont working in St st until scarf measures approx. 134 cm/52.8 in. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 120 sts. Cont working in patt A until work measures approx. 146 cm/57.5 in (end cable patt as charted). Change to needles size 2 ½ mm, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 80 sts. Work approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in K1,P1 rib.

When working a patt with 2 clr, it is important to maintain the order of clr over your finger. Always hold the darker clr in front throughout the whole project.

Using needle size 2 ½ mm and green yarn, cast on 152 – 276 – 200 – 224 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 – 4 – 5 – 5 cm /1.6-1.6-2-2 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 168 – 192 – 216 – 240 sts.


Place marker each side, 85 – 97 – 109 – 121 sts for front, and 83 – 95 – 107 – 119 sts for back. Cont working in patt A. When work measures approx. 22 – 27 – 34 – 38 cm/8.7 – 10.6 – 13.4 – 15 in, bind off first and last st on front + mid front st for V-neck. Next rnd: Cast on 4 sts over each bound-off 3 sts (= purl every rnd, will be cut open later on). Cont working in patt as charted. Dec **same time** 1 st every 2nd rnd both sides of the armholes, and both sides of the V-neck as foll: K2tog before a marker, and sl 1 st, K1, pssso after a marker. Rep dec at armhole edges 3 – 4 – 4 – 5 times, and at V-neck edges until 19 – 24 – 29 – 34 sts rem for shoulder, and work measures 36 – 43 – 52 – 58 cm/14.2 – 16.9 – 20.5 – 22.8 in. Bind off.

Finishing: Dampen the work slightly from WS. Sew 2 smallest zigzag seams around armholes, and mid front for V-neck. Cut open between seams. Sew normal zigzag over cut edges. Join shoulder seams.

Armhole bands: Using needles size 2½ mm and green yarn, pick or knit up approx. 78 – 90 – 100 – 112 sts. Work in rnds 3 cm/1.2 in in K1,P1 rib. Bind off in rib. Turn inside out, and using needles size 2½ mm and green yarn, pick or knit up approx. 78 – 90 – 100 – 112 sts. Work back and forth 5 rows in St st for seam allowance. Work same for the other armhole band.

Neck band: Using needles size 2½ mm and green yarn, pick or knit up approx. 124 – 136 – 148 – 162 sts. Work 1 rnd in St st, and cont working in K1,P1 rib. Dec 1 st both sides of mid front st. Rep dec **every** rnd. Cont working until neck band measures approx. 3 cm/1.2 in. Bind off in rib. Turn work inside out. Beg from mid V-neck. Using needles size 2½ mm and green yarn, pick or knit up approx. 124 – 136 – 148 – 162 sts. Work back and forth 5 rows in St st for seam allowance. Bind off. Sew seam allowance over cut edge. Weave in all ends on WS.





SWEATER

Using needles size 2½ mm and blue (red) yarn, cast on 168-184-200-224-240 sts. Work in rnds 4-5-5-6-6 cm/1.6-2-2-2.4-2.4 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3 mm. Cont working in rnds in St st. Place markers each side, 85-93-101-113-121 sts for front, and 83-91-99-111-119 sts for back. When work measures approx. 24-27-34-38-41 cm/ 9.4-10.6-13.4-15-16.1 in, bind off 12-12-16-16-16 sts at each side (6-6-8-8-8 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit sleeves.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 2½ mm and blue (red) yarn, cast on 44-48-48-52-52 sts. Work in rib same as for body. Change to needles size 3 mm. Knit 1 rnd, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 53-57-59-63-65 sts. Cont working in rnds in St st. Place a marker beg of rnd = mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 3-3-3 ½ -2 ½ -2 ½ cm/1.2-1.2-1.4-1-1 in until there is altog. 67-73-79-89-95 sts. When work measures the given length, or as desired, bind off 12-12-16-16-16 sts mid under sleeve (6-6-8-8-8 sts both sides of the markers). Leave rem sts on holder. Leave work aside, and knit same for the other sleeve.

Yoke: Slip all pieces on same circular needle, sleeves over the bound-off sts for armholes = 254-282-294-338-366 sts on a rnd. Work 2-3-4-6-7 cm/0.8-1.2-1.6-2.4-2.8 in in St st with blue (red) yarn, and dec evenly across first rnd number of sts to be 248-280-288-336-360 sts. Cont working in rnds in patt I and dec as charted. After that cont working in patt II, III and IIII, and dec where arrows point out = 124-105-108-126-135 sts rem on a rnd. Change to blue (red) yarn. Work 1 rnd in St st, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 100-104-108-120-126 sts. Work 5-5-6-6-6 cm/2-2-2.4-2.4-2.4 in in K1,P1 rib. Bind off rather loosely. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS. Sew under arm seams, and weave in on WS.

Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 168 – 196 – 224 sts. Work in rnds approx. 5 – 5 – 6 cm/2-2-2.4 in in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 178 – 206 – 234 sts. Place markers at each

side, 90 – 104 – 118 sts for front, and 88 – 102 – 116 sts for back. Inc for cable patt as foll: Seed st over 16 – 23 – 30 sts, inc 12 sts over next 17 sts (= 29 sts) = patt A, inc 4 sts over next 24 sts (= 28 sts) = patt B, inc 12 sts over next 17 sts (= 29 sts) = patt A, Seed st over 31 – 45 – 59 sts, inc 12 sts over next 17 sts (= 29 sts) = patt A, inc 4 sts over next 24 sts (= 28 sts) = patt B, inc 12 sts over next 17 sts (= 29 sts) = patt A, and end with Seed st over 15 – 22 – 29 sts = 234-262-290 sts. Cont working as established. When work measures approx. 25 – 33 – 39 cm/9.8-13-15.4 in, bind off 16 sts at each side for armholes (8 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit the sleeves.



Sleeves: Using needles size 2 ½ mm, cast on 48 – 52 – 52 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 – 5 – 5 cm/1.6-2-2 in in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 3 mm. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 57 – 61 – 61 sts. Place a marker beg of the rnd (= mid under sleeve). Inc for cable patt as foll: Seed st over 20 – 22 – 22 sts, inc 12 sts over next 17 sts (= 29 sts) = patt A, and end with Seed st over 20 – 22 – 22 sts = 69 – 73 – 73 sts on a rnd. Work as established. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 3 – 2 ½ – 2 cm/ 1.2-1-0.8 in until there is 85 – 97 – 107 sts on a rnd, and sleeve measures approx. 30 – 37 – 44 cm/ in (inc sts are worked in Seed st).

Bind off 16 sts mid under sleeve (8 sts both sides of the marker). Leave work aside, and knit the other sleeve.


Yoke: Cont working in patt same as before, and knit all pieces on same circular needle size 3 mm = 340-392-440 sts on a rnd. Place markers at each 4 seam lines, and beg raglan-dec: Beg 2 sts before a marker, sl 1 st, K1,psso, K2tog. Rep dec at each 4 seamline every 2nd rnd until 116 – 128 – 136 sts rem on a rnd.

Next rnd: Dec 4 mid front sts (= mid sts of patt B), 3 mid sts of right sleeve (= patt A), 4 mid back sts (= mid sts of patt B), and 3 sts mid sts of left sleeve (= patt A). Change to needles size 2½ mm. Adjust over next rnd number of sts to suit K2,P2 rib cont from patt A for neck band. Dec the number of sts to be 100 – 112 – 120 sts, and work approx. 6-7-7 cm/2.4-2.4-2.8 in in K2,P2 rib. Bind off in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Finishing : Sew under arm seams.
