

Design 7154 • Schachenmayr SMC JACKET

Size: 62/68 (74/80, 86/92) (about 3/6 (9/12, 18/24 months) Directions for the smaller size are before the brackets, with larger sizes inside. If there is only one figure, it applies to all sizes.

All measurements are in centimetres (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54).

Tip! Before starting work, highlight all the details relating to the desired size.

Materials: Schachenmayr/SMC Baby Wool Color, 125 (150/175)g #00182 pastel color.

2.75-3.75mm Milward needles, 1 button about 18mm across.

Rib pattern: alt K3, P3.

Tension: in Rib Patt (stretched lightly) 30 sts and 36 rows/rounds, each to 10cm.

METHOD

Work jacket in one piece across, starting at right sleeve, see arrow in Line Chart.

Cast on 47 (53, 59) sts and work in Rib Patt; start with a WS row, and after edge st start with K3 (P3, K3).

For **sleeve shaping** inc at each end 1 st on 6th row once, then 1 st at each end as foll:

Size 62/68: 1 st on every 6th row 8 times,

Size 74/80: 1 st on every 6th row 8 times and 1 st on every 4th row 3 times,

Size 86/92: 1 st on every 6th row 7 times and 1 st on every 4th row 7 times.

There are now 65 (77, 89) sts on the needle.

On 4th foll row cast on at each end for right front and back 42 (48, 54) sts each = 149 (173, 197) sts and on RS row start with edge st, K3; on WS row start with edge st, P3. When work measures 9 (10, 11)cm (= 32 (36, 40) rows) from start of front and back divide work as foll: for right front work 71 (83, 95) in patt and leave on a holder, cast off 7 for neck, over rem 71 (83, 95) sts work 8 (10, 12)cm (= 30 (36, 42) rows) for back, leave all sts on a holder.

Cont over the 71 (83, 95) sts on holder for **right front**, and when front measures 16 (18, 20)cm (= 58 (64, 72)



rows) cast off all sts.

For **left front** cast on 71 (83, 95) sts and work in Rib Patt; start 1st WS row with edge st, P3. On 5th (WS) row work 1 buttonhole as foll: work edge st and 24 in patt, cast off 2, work rem sts in patt; on next row cast on 2 over those cast off.

When left front measures 7 (8, 9)cm (= 26 (28, 32) rows) work sts of left front in patt, cast on 7 sts anew for neck edge, then work the sts off the holder across back and cont over all 149 (173, 197) sts.

When back measures 26 (30, 34)cm (= 94 (108, 122) rows) cast off at each end 42 (48, 54) sts once, and cont over 65 (77, 89) sts for **left sleeve**.

At the same time dec for sleeve shaping at each end 1 st on every 4th row 1 (4, 8) times, and 1 st on every 6th row 8 (8, 7) times = 47 (53, 59) sts. On 5th foll row cast off all sts. Total height of work 58 (68, 78)cm.

To make up: block piece to measurements, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry. Close sleeve and side seams. Sew on button.
