

Design 6746 Hat with a double edge to fit 38 and 41cm head



METHOD

Start with the circular needle and change to double-pointed needles as required. For the double cuff cast on 84(90) sts loosely and work in st-st in rounds. When work measures 5cm, or on 16th round, work picot edging as foll: *K2 tog, yarnover, rep from *.

K yarn-overs on foll row. On 16th foll round pick up sts of cast on round with auxiliary needles and hold at back of work, then knit 1 from front needle tog with 1 from back needle throughout. Cont in st-st, on 1st round inc 1 st after every 3rd st 28 times (alt after every 2nd and 3rd st 36 times) = 112(126) sts.

When work measures 7(8)cm (= 21(24) rounds) from double cuff, mark every 16(18)th st 7 times and knit each marked st tog with the preceding st = 105(119) sts. Then knit every marked st tog with the resp preceding st on every 2nd round another 14(16) times = 7 sts. Cut yarn, bring through rem sts., pull up firmly and fasten off. Weave in yarn tail. Height of hat about 22(25) cm.

Sew button to pulled up sts of hat.

Directions for the smaller size are before the stroke, with larger sizes behind. If there is only one figure, it applies to all sizes. All measurements are in centimeters (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54).

Materials: Schachenmayr Merino Extrafine 120, 50(75)g cream #00102.

3-4mm [US 3-6] double-pointed needles and same size circular needle 40cm long, or size to obtain gauge, 1 silver/brass button about 1.5cm across.

Stockinette stitch (st-st): K all rounds. Gauge: 22 sts and 30 rows/rounds st-st, each to 10 cm [4"].
